## Monday

### English:

1. **English in Practice: Day 111 and 112**
2. **Starlight Reader:** Read the text 'Amazing Grace' on page 10. The new vocabulary is highlighted in bold. Make a list of these new words on a blank page in your Home Learning Copy. Find out what they mean and see if you can put them into another sentence to show that you understand them. Complete page 11. You do not need to write the answers to Part A - you can answer them out loud. Make sure to use full sentences.
3. **Recount:** In your English Copy, write a short recount about your mid-term break. Remember to use sentence openers and good punctuation. Use past tense verbs like: watched, walked, played, ate, brought, took, cooked,. You can write about the whole week, or just one day or even just one activity like: a game you played, a movie you watched or a book you read.
4. **Recount:** *Instead of writing your own recount today - fill in the recount organiser for 'Amazing Grace' on page 13 of your Starlight Workbook.*

2. **Mental Maths:** Count in 11s - up to 55 - Can you see the pattern?

### English:

3. **Read at Home:** Read the narrative on page 69 'Seagull' - Answer the questions out loud. There is no need to write them down.

2. **Mental Maths:** Count in 11s - up to 99 - Can you see the pattern?
3. **Maths Topic: Addition with Renaming:** Complete page 138 in your Planet Maths Workbook
